Butter-yellow colour and aromas of freshly sliced apples and steely minerality. It is quite round and supple on the palate. The ripe apple flavour carries through with a touch of lemon and a bit of creaminess to the mineraly-astringent finish.

Purity in a glass, this Riesling is a magnificent micro site Riesling that shows aromas and flavours of lime dominated citrus married with stone fruit characters.

Dense dark cherry notes lead into brown spice. A beautifully textured plush mid palate, with fine, elegant textural tannins. Cherry and spice notes to finish.	
13 Burlotto Barolo DOCG Italy	110
Red fruit, mint and liquorice, potpourri and a touch of earthiness. Medium bodied, fresh and lively, blood orange succulence and red berries and cherries, fine drag of dusty tannin, perfume and vigour to its long finish. Finely wrought and quite beautiful.	
13 Antinori Tignanello Toscana Italy IGT Italy	145
Bright red fruit up front, followed by vanilla, chocolate and leather, with spiciness and balsamic characters adding complexity. Subtle tannins and fresh acidity give the wine great length.

11 Pewsey Vale The Contours Eden Valley SA	82
Pale straw with green hues, the aromas are intense but restrained with classic lemon and a floral influence with nuances of bottle aged toast, clove oil and lemongrass.	
13 Valli Old Vine Central Otago New Zealand	85
Lime, grapefruit, orange blossom, green apple and mineral flavours are among the more obvious taste descriptors.	
15 Pyramid Valley Rose Vineyard Marlborough New Zealand	110
Very low yields and labour intensive biodynamic viticulture create a powerful Riesling, at once rich and precise, full bodied, but with stark mineral cut.	
17 Grosset Polish Hill Clare Valley SA	119
The flavours are tight, fine and dry and show schisty minerality and bright lime zest flavours. It's delicately fragrant with lemon, lime and grapefruit as well as a slatey mineral expression.

- 17 Arfion Pinot Grigio Yarra Valley 63  
Red apple, rose and spicy cinnamon aromas with a hint of bread crust goodness. The palate is dry, savoury and textural with preserved lemon rind, fennel and pear.
- 16 Wanaka Road Pinot Gris Central Otago NZ 65  
This wine is all about texture and flavour. Pear, apples, & spicy tones are underlined by aromas of tropical fruit and a soft fullness of flavour. Nice acidity provides a refreshing backbone to the wine. A dry style that is extremely good with food.
- 11 Chalmers Fiano Heathcote VIC 68  
White flowers, fresh white stone fruits and flinty notes on the nose. Almond bitterness and savoury lees contact characters balance more stonefruit on the focused but generous, textured palate completed by a lingering, refreshing finish.
- 16 Mac Forbes EB23 Arneis Yarra Valley VIC 70  
Arneis hails from the great region of Piemonte in Italy. Mac developed this wine with his mother in mind to stop her from buying "boring" Pinot Grigio. Crisp, bright, mineral and racy, with a soft fruit lift and plenty of complexity.
- 15 Greywacke Pinot Gris Marlborough NZ 72  
A delicious combination of ripe summer fruits and delicate floral perfume - citrus blossom and elderflower entwined with nectarines and white peaches, mandarin and cantaloupe with a twist of lemon.
- 16 Unico Zelo River Sand Fiano Riverland SA 75  
A highly aromatic white, with scents of jasmine, apples, pear and grapefruit pith. It is wondrously textured, with softness of structure and acid, which helps the lemon and ginger flavours glide across the palate.
- 16 La Petite Mort Amphora V.M.R. Ballandean QLD 75  
Whole berries of Viognier, Marsanne and Roussanne are fermented in a terracotta amphora for 20 days – skins and all! This results in an "amber wine" which is definitely something out of the ordinary. A fantastic wine with plenty to offer.
- 15 Quartz Reef Pinot Gris Central Otago NZ 77  
Lemon-gold with an alluring bouquet of nutmeg, honey, ginger and white peach. Voluptuous texture with spice and richness finishing beautifully dry.
- 11 Tyrrell's HVD Semillon Hunter Valley NSW 90  
From the 103 year old HVD vineyard, this wine shows lifted floral aromatics and a palate that is generous with soft citrus flavours. The acidity is soft making the wine quite approachable, a result of the warmer 2011 vintage.
- 14 Castagna Harlequin Roussanne blend Beechworth VIC 95  
Julian Castagna is, in my mind, Australia's most important and influential biodynamic producer. The 'Harlequin' is a Roussanne, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Viognier blend that has been fermented on skins. This wine is full and textural with a honeyed spicy savoury overtone. Not your typical aromatic white, it has much more structure, texture and complexity.

 Located in Relbia, just ten minutes south of Launceston is the state of the art Josef Chromy winery, producing wines of great purity. Elderflower, gooseberry and passionfruit aromas with subtle notes of white flowers and melon.
- 16 Cullen Mangan Vineyard Sem|Sauv Blanc Margaret River WA 65  
 Complex aromas of tropical fruit, freshly cut grass and lemon citrus. The palate has plenty of drive and displays intense notes of limes, lemon and gooseberry. Supported gently by French oak.
- 16 Dog Point Marlborough New Zealand 67  
 Pioneers of organic viticulture in New Zealand, this wine offers a balance of classic Marlborough characters, balanced with smoky, flinty notes more commonly found in the Loire Valley of France.
- 16 Greywacke Marlborough New Zealand 73  
 A musky fusion of sweet scented fruits - nectarines, peaches and nashi pears with a dash of orange zest - intermingled with a floral perfume reminiscent of star jasmine and citrus blossom.
- 15 Michael Hall Adelaide Hills SA 76  
 Barrel fermented, combining blackcurrant, asparagus, flint and citrus with a delicate vanillin viscosity.
- 16 Sorrenberg Sauvignon Blanc|Semillon Beechworth VIC 86  
 100% barrel fermented with natural yeast and extended lees contact. This wine has racy acidity, but at the same time is rich and full on the palate. Aromas and flavours of guava, gooseberries and a hint of freshly mown hay combine with citrus and minerality creating a long mouthfeel.
- 16 Cloudy Bay Marlborough New Zealand 90  
 Fresh, aromatic and intense without going either overboard (or underboard for that matter) about it all. It feels cool and inviting. It takes nips out of you, but not big bites. It has a sense of balance.
- 13 Cloudy Bay Te Koko Marlborough New Zealand 135  
 Te Koko is an intriguing and alternative style of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas of lemon thyme, mandarin blossom and stonefruit combine harmoniously with ginger spice and nutty and savoury tones, underlined by exotic tropical notes.

- 16 **Te Mata Estate Hawke's Bay New Zealand** 55  
Aromas of white meadow flowers, French vanilla and floral, juicy peaches. The palate carries rock melon, sweet lemon, candied lime and complex notes of biscuit, stone-fruit and mixed nuts. Pure, clean and fresh.
- 16 **Payten & Jones Valley Vignerons Yarra Valley VIC** 60  
Unashamedly old school Australian Chardonnay, but structured and precise. Rich, powerful, toasty and savoury, with great length and balance from bright natural acidity.
- 15 **Milton Opou Vineyard Gisborne New Zealand** 65  
An old vineyard by NZ standards, planted in 1969 and certified Biodynamic. In writing this tasting note, I feel that it is best to quote the winemaker verbatim; "It smells like yellow and tastes like the words of AA Milne".
- 16 **Lightfoot & Sons Myrtle Point Gippsland VIC** 68  
Generous stone fruit and citrus character complement the texture and complexity achieved with barrel fermentation, lees stirring and maturation in French Oak barriques and puncheons.
- 16 **Kooyong Clonale Mornington Peninsula VIC** 68  
Kooyong Clonale Chardonnay has a complex nose with citrus varietal aromas meshed with classy oak. Seamless on the palate with long, fine cool-climate flavours.
- 16 **Stefano Lubiana Primavera Derwent Valley TAS** 72  
The Derwent River has created an exceptional vineyard site with marine influences on 3 sides of the vineyard along with the stoney and silt soils providing ideal conditions for this textured and elegant Chardonnay.
- 12 **Moortangi Estate Yarra Valley VIC** 79  
The Yarra Valley Chardonnay shows aromas of peach fruit, ripe grapefruit and subtle toast/cashew nuts. The palate is lively and generous with stone fruit characters, and are carried through by a solid citrus backbone that cuts a fine line through the palate and brings freshness to the wine
- 16 **Craggy Range Gimblett Gravels Hawke's Bay New Zealand** 84  
Pale lemon straw. Bright nose of ripe apple, peach, freshly cracked river stones and the finest of oak. Wonderful concentration of rich stone fruits with citrus like acidity and good phenolic tension to carry the wine long towards the dry finish.
- 14 **Scorpo Estate Mornington Peninsula VIC** 94  
Paul Scorpo produces a Chardonnay of complexity and character. Aromas of nectarine, minerals and vanilla bean give way to a mouthfeel of peach and citrus and a lovely acid backbone.
- 14 **Cloudy Bay Marlborough New Zealand** 97  
The nose is bright with aromas of stone fruit, white chocolate and a touch of smoke. Lemon balm and green plums combine with flint and char on a fleshy palate and lingering finish.

# CHARDONNAY

- 15 Shaw & Smith M3 Adelaide Hills SA 98**  
Sourced and grown in the Adelaide Hills, this is a fine example of how good Chardonnay from this region can be. This is a blend of 3 different cultivars of the Chardonnay grape. Bunch pressed and in part wild fermented. Partial malolactic fermentation imparts further complexity.
- 15 Michael Hall Adelaide Hills SA 104**  
Made in a generous style, the blend of grapefruit, peach and cream flavours filling the mouth with both flavour and texture. The finish then shoots dryness, in smoky/minerally form, straight at you, and beyond.
- 15 Cobaw Ridge Macedon Ranges VIC 110**  
Dedicated biodynamic farmers with their stella site set at 600-or-so meters above sea level in the cool upper reaches of the Macedon Ranges. The wine is made with no additions, no adjustments or chicanery. Full flavoured, generous, a touch savoury. Stacks in character and quality, from a good place and good people.
- 12 Medhurst Reserve Yarra Valley VIC 118**  
Grapefruit, white peach, oatmeal and mineral aromas introduce a rich, smooth palate, and a lingering aftertaste of fruit and toasty oak.
- 16 Bindi Kostas Rind Macedon Ranges VIC 122**  
An intense, mineral wine fully ripe but lean, taught and intense with savoury, creamy elements. Fragrant notes of orange blossom, nectarine stone, spice and subtle nuttiness are usual with a vibrant, tight, long palate highlighted by clean acidity, wonderful texture and fine length.
- 12 Tyrrell's Vat 47 Hunter Valley NSW 135**  
A pioneer in the modern Australian Chardonnay stakes, the Vat 47 from the Hunter Valley has a silky bouquet of melon stone fruit and creamy oak that is followed by a palate of extraordinary balance and length.
- 14 Ten Minutes by Tractor Wallis Mornington Peninsula VIC 145**  
The Wallis vineyard produces a very particular expression of Chardonnay that, each year, stands out in the Ten Minutes by Tractor range. It has a high-toned finesse that is immediately recognisable with its expressions of minerals, herbs and citrus on the nose and precision with building power on the palate.
- 16 Felton Road Bannockburn Central Otago New Zealand 149**  
This winery retains its cult status by continually producing wines of poise, class and adhering to strict biodynamic principals. The Bannockburn Chardonnay is at this stage pert and linear, with floral and citrus notes.
- 15 Savaterre Beechworth VIC 165**  
This is the luxury car of Chardonnay, with all the trimmings. Toasty, woodsmoke, flint and sulphur all over the throbbing golden peach fruit. There's nuts and a kernel quality there also topped with honey and almonds. It rolls long through the mouth. Powerful long strides. One for the big Chardonnay lovers, no doubt. But done beautifully.
- 11 Yarra Yering Yarra Valley VIC 180**  
Grapefruit, white peach and kumquat aromas with hints of ginger and toast. The medium-bodied palate has a nice silky texture offset by vibrant acidity and a touch of oak before finishing long.

## OTHER EUROPEAN WHITE WINES

- 14 **Schloss Gobelsburg** Steissetz Grüner Veltliner Kamptal Austria 86  
Lip-smacking refreshment. Zesty, with yeasty, earthy notes and refreshing grapefruit peel and a clean, zingy finish.
- 15 **Kühling-Gillot** Nierstein Kabinett Riesling Rheinhessen Germany 85  
Carolin Spanier-Gillot was the first woman to receive Germany's coveted 'Vintner of the Year' title. This is zippy Riesling, with slatey minerality and a touch of the kerosene character so sought after in Rhein Riesling.
- 15 **Telmo Rodriguez** Gaba do Xil Godello Valdeorras Spain 65  
There's a hint of lanolin and wax as usual for Godello, but lemon-melon-pear are the main flavours. The texture is silky with mineral and a nip of fresh acid to finish.
- 14 **Schlumberger** Les Princes Abbés Pinot Gris Alsace France 75  
Pear, smoke, apricot and honey. Rich and round in the mouth, with juicy, lively flavours of orchard fruits.
- 15 **Billaud-Simon** Chablis AC Bourgogne France 120  
A balance of power and elegance, with soft minerality, vanilla, intense ripe fruits and a touch of brioche.
- 13 **Vincent Girardin** Saint-Aubin 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Bourgogne France 154  
From the biodynamically farmed 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Les Murgers des Dents de Chien vineyard. 11<sup>th</sup> generation grower Vincent Girardin excels at producing whites with depth of fruit and exquisite balance.
- 14 **Vincent Girardin** Meursault Narvaux Bourgogne France 170  
The 50 year old vines are adjacent to the famous premier cru parcel "Les Genevrières". Rich and powerful, balanced by lively citrus. Lots of excitement with good structure and a minerally undertow.
- 14 **Bernard Moreau et Fils** Chassagne-Montrachet Bourgogne FR 180  
A pungent nose combines notes of petrol, resin, matchstick and various white orchard fruit scents. The very round, suave and highly seductive flavours possess good muscle and power before culminating in a solidly persistent and layered finish.

Located in the North-East of Italy, Veneto is the home of the amazing white wine of Soave (mostly garganega).

Trentino and Alto-Adige are often treated as an old, married couple. It makes more sense to treat them as two different regions that happen to be neighbours and combine forces when it suits. Both produce refreshing, bright whites that bridge the gap between Germany, Austria and Italy.

|    | Aromas of freshly sliced apples and steely minerality. The ripe apple flavour carries through with a touch of lemon and a bit of creaminess to the mineraly astringent finish.  |     |

# ITALIAN WHITE WINES

## Piemonte

Piemonte is not usually thought of as white wine country, but two characterful wines are well worth looking out for. Gavi, made from the local Cortese grape is dry, creamy and appley. Arneis in local dialect means "Little Rascal". Despite being difficult to grow, it is remarkably easy to drink.

- 15 **La Raia Gavi DOCG** 67  
Aromatic, youthful, vividly fruity nose is herby and fresh. The palate is crisp with nice texture. Fresh style with good acidity.
- 16 **Mauro Molino Roero Arneis DOCG** 76  
Straw yellow in colour with greenish highlights, intense floral and fruity aromas, well structured with a balanced acidity and a long finish.
- 15 **Marchesi di Barolo Gavi di Gavi DOCG** 80  
Apples and green almonds on the nose, with an overtone of chamomile flowers. Gently fruity on the palate with balanced mineral notes.
- 15 **Michele Chiarlo Rovereto Gavi di Gavi DOCG** 95  
Made from the Cortese grape grown around the Village of Gavi, this wine is dry, spicy with a pleasant mineral and floral tone and a mouth-watering, refreshing and long finish.
- 13 **Gaja Gaia & Rey Chardonnay Langhe DOC** 600  
Remarkably balanced and deeply sophisticated, the '13 Gaia & Rey shows why this wine is arguably the most collectable Italian white. The nose bursts with succulent tropical, orchard and citrus fruits that are framed with spice, almond and wildflowers, but it's on the palate that this wine really delivers, coating the mouth with a creamy feel even as the wine builds to a fresh, lingering finish. Deriving from Gaja's almost nine-acre Treiso vineyard planted in 1979, this wine is named for Angelo Gaja's oldest daughter, Gaia Gaja, and his grandmother, Clotilde Rey.

## Lombardia

Lombardy is developing a reputation for its still white, spritzy and sparkling wines from Franciacorta and Oltrepò Pavese, its wines offer great variety and character, with a mixture of modern and traditional, as well as native and foreign grape varieties.

- 13 **Ca di Frara Apogèa Riesling Superiore Oltrepò Pavese DOC** 65  
Body is medium and aftertaste has a pleasant almond bitterness. This is not your average riesling, but once you overcome the surprise you will enjoy it.

## Marche

The Marche region is well known for the quality of its whites made from the prolific Verdicchio grape. In terms of overall quality though, Verdicchio in all its forms undoubtedly ranks among Italy's finest white wines.

- 14 **Belisario Terre di Valbona Verdicchio di Matelica DOC** 48  
The palate is fuller bodied than the nose initially give out. The acidity is well balanced, the texture is appealing and the finish is long and quite rich.

# ITALIAN WHITE WINES

## Toscana

Tuscany is one of the most famous and prolific wine regions anywhere in Europe. Its vineyards produce an array of internationally recognised wines in various styles. These go far beyond the well-known reds, and include dry whites such as Vernaccia di San Gimignano and sweet Vin Santo.

- 15 **Santa Christina Campogrande Orvieto Classico DOC** 45  
Straw yellow in colour, the palate is balanced, soft and fresh in the flavour with a long fruit-driven finish. A blend of Trebbiano, Malvasia and Chardonnay
- 15 **Marchesi Mazzei Belgardo Vermentino di Toscana IGT** 52  
Medium bodied, large fruit (yellow peach) aromas, pleasingly mineral taste
- 15 **Podere del Paradiso Vernaccia di San Gimignano DOCG** 54  
Perfumes of wildflowers and fresh apricots show on the nose, chalk dust and white pepper blend with poached white fruits and a touch of honey.
- NV **Bibi Graetz Casamatta Bianco** 58  
Lovely perfumes of fresh red apple, honeydew melon and magnolia flowers, while there is very good depth of fruit and a rich, flavourful finish.
- 16 **Tenuta di Ghizzano Il Ghizzano Bianco Costa Toscana IGT** 75  
Made from traditional Tuscan white grapes: Trebbiano, Vermentino and Malvasia Bianca. This is a fresh and fruity wine, easy drinking, but not at all simple. Long, fine acidity and subtle grip makes this a wonderful match with any seafood dish on the Locale menu.
- 15 **Isole E Olena Collezione Privata Chardonnay Toscana IGT** 139  
Rich aromas of toasted almonds with buttery notes. On the palate, there is great balance between rich, ripe fruit, creamy brioche and complex minerality.
- 15 **Gaja Ca' Marcanda Vistamare Toscana IGT** 165  
The playful name of this wine was inspired by the sea breeze, sun, and cheerful and light-hearted outlook of the Tuscan coast. The vineyards used for Vistamare actually enjoy a panoramic view of the Tuscan horizon and their grapes are gently inebriated by the saltine air and brilliant colours of the Tuscan sea. Vermentino and Viognier.

## Campania

Campania is the "shin" of Italy's boot, anchored by its capital, Naples. Its name comes from Campania felix, a Latin phrase roughly meaning "happy land". The region has strong historical links to wine and vine, dating back to the 12th Century BC, and is one of Italy's very oldest wine regions.

- 15 **Ciro Picariello Greco di Tufo** 95  
Named after the nearby village of Tufo, this stunning wine is savory, mineral, long and complex with orange blossom, citrus peel and lemon characters.

# ITALIAN WHITE WINES

## Abruzzo

Italy is seldom known for the simplicity of its wines, yet the ruggedly mountainous region of Abruzzo offers an abundance of delightful, uncomplicated wines that tend to represent very good value.

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| 13 | <b>Tenute Ulisse Unico Trebbiano d'Abruzzo DOP</b>   | 55 |
|    | Straw-yellow in colour with delicate aromas of green apple and flowers, is smooth, dry, versatile, and always refreshing.                              |    |
| 15 | <b>Tenute Ulisse Unico Pecorino Terre di Chieti IGP</b>  | 55 |
|    | A classic Pecorino-based dry and mineral, straw-yellow in colour and has an elegantly floral bouquet, sometimes spiced with a faint hint of liquorice. |    |

|    | Pale yellow colour. Intense and persistent. Smooth taste, fresh and balanced   |    |

## Puglia

The southern portion of the region is a flat and fertile peninsula that forms the characteristic heel of the Italian "boot". Puglia has always been the engine-room of Italian wine production.

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| 15 | <b>Tormaresca Chardonnay Puglia IGT</b>   | 47  |
|    | Tormaresca is the world famous Antinori family's outpost in Puglia. Shows fairly restrained aromas of lemon citrus and white peach.   |     |
| 14 | <b>Cantele Teresamanara Chardonnay Salento IGT</b>  | 98  |
|    | Silky in the mouth, velvety and mellifluous, with freshness and sweet spices imparted by selected wood used during aging. The finish wins over the drinker with its length and its terroir expression.  |     |

# ITALIAN WHITE WINES

## Sicilia

One of Europe's oldest wine growing regions, the island is home to some unique varieties not found anywhere else. Many modern Sicilian producers have embraced ancient farming and winemaking techniques, resulting in expressive wines that are equal to the best of any of the great regions of Italy.

- 14 Feudo Arancio Grillo Sicilia DOC** **40**  
A wine that shows balanced citrus fruit and floral characters and delicate acidity.
- 14 Tasca Regaleali Bianco Sicilia DOC** **65**  
Green apple and pear flavours are carried over from the nose to form the basis, hints of grapefruit and white peach add further interest.
- 14 Graci Arcuria Etna Bianco DOC** **82**  
Tight, crisp and clean, perfectly balanced taste of the wine reveals an interesting mix of shades of ripe stone fruit and tropical fruit with spicy mineral notes. Wine leaves a vivid long aftertaste.
- 15 I Vigneri Aurora Carricante** **120**  
Reminiscent of top Premier Cru white Burgundy while still showing the pure terroir of Etna with exotic spice, flinty mineral and a lovely pale yellow/gold colour, with sexy white peach, tropical notes and kumquat as well as soft butterscotch, salty chalk and lemon marmalade.

## Calabria

A wine region of southern Italy, effectively a large peninsula jutting out between the Ionian and Tyrrhenian seas. It is divided from Sicily by the narrow Strait of Messina, and its northern border with Basilicata is marked by the southern Apennine peaks.

- 13 Barone G.R. Macrì Terre di Gerace Calabria IGT** **65**  
Fresh aromas of citrus, white flowers, vanilla and mint. Fine acidity on the palate. This wine is deliciously fresh and savory. 60% Greco Bianco, 40% Inzolia.

# ROSATO

- 15 **Palama Alba Rossa Salento Rosato IGP Puglia ITA** 48  
Rosé obtained by the wine-making of the local Negroamaro and Black Malvasia grapes. Brilliant rosé-coloured, fresh dry-flavoured, it best suits hors d'oeuvres and or pasta dishes with tomato sauce.
- 16 **A Mano Rosato Puglia IGT ITA** 54  
Bright pink in colour with a lively, youthful perfume of ripe strawberries and a touch of fresh mint. On the palate it is surprisingly full-bodied with good structure, perfectly balanced with a delicate fruit character and zesty, lightly spiced finish.
- 16 **Bertani Bertarose Verona IGT Veneto ITA** 60  
A lychee-pink colour. Fresh aromas of pomegranate and redcurrants with notes of white flowers. Decisive on the palate, good body and good balance between acidity and tanginess. Excellent length.
- 17 **Medhurst Yarra Valley VIC** 62  
Redcurrant, touch of creaminess, maybe a suggestion of fennel or similar. Clean lines, excellent flavour – delivered sotto voce – very subtle powdery texture and a tangy fresh strawberry finish of good length.
- 14 **Leone De Castris Five Roses Salento IGT Puglia ITA** 70  
A crisp attack with pleasing roundness, however balanced by alcohol, good body and intense flavours. The finish is persistent with flavours of raspberry, cherry and plum.
- 16 **Farr Rising Saignée Geelong VIC** 72  
Farr Rising Saignée is part of the rosé revolution that is happening in Australia right now. Bright pink, tinged with magenta, complexity is added through barrel fermentation; immaculate length and balance.
- 15 **Scorpo Mornington Peninsula VIC** 75  
Vibrant salmon pink in colour this wine exhibits musk, raspberry, strawberry and rose petals on the nose. Clean, crisp acid finish, with a hint of fine tannin.
- 16 **Le Gran Cros L'Esprit Côtes de Provence FR** 79  
The palate is charming; red fruit and hints of mandarin in evidence, fennel and laurel behind that with a finely etched finish of balletic poise and a real sense of interest.
- 15 **Graci Etna Rosato Sicily IGT ITA** 82  
The red grapes Nerello Mascalese and Nerello Cappuccio, and white grapes Carricante and Catarratto. Intervention of any kind is extremely limited, both in the vineyard and in the cellar. Their sole objective is to reflect the personalities of their vineyards and the sublime differences between harvests.
- 15 **Mac Forbes Woori Yallock Yarra Valley VIC** 90  
If you're going to make a rosé, and you're Mac Forbes, you make it from your best immaculately-farmed vineyard, from the same pinot noir you would use for your single vineyard offering but picked for the style. No mucking about, straight to the upper echelon. Could this be the best rosé ever produced in Australia?
- 15 **Chateau de Pibarnon Bandol FR** 125  
One of the benchmark rosés of France, this wine never misses a beat. The texture silky and round, yet the generosity is shot through with spicy, savoury freshness that reflects the cool, limestone soils and the altitude of the vines here.

# PINOT NOIR

- 15 **Wairau River Marlborough NZ** 70  
The Pinot Noir shows lifted aromas of ripe cherries and spice. The palate is soft and generous with delicate primary fruit characters of wild berries shadowed by subtle toasty oak.
- 16 **Scorpo Noirien Mornington Peninsula VIC** 72  
Scorpo Noirien Pinot Noir has lovely varietal aromas - sappy, mulchy, dark cherry. Supple, long and textured. Attractive sour cherry rhubarb finish.
- 15 **Fromm La Strada Marlborough NZ** 72  
Fromm's passion for Pinot Noir is reflected in the attention to detail shown in the vineyard and throughout the winemaking process. The blend which makes up each years La Strada Pinot Noir by Fromm depends on what nature has given in each of their vineyards.
- 14 **Riposte The Sabre Adelaide Hills SA** 77  
Bright colour in the glass is followed by a lifted floral nose with a savoury edge. The palate is fresh, clean and superbly powerful. A delight.
- 16 **Ten Minutes by Tractor 10X Mornington Peninsula VIC** 80  
Deeply flavoured, predominantly savoury release with tobacco, sap, wood smoke and forestry characters threading strands of intricate flavour through black cherry, almost olives fruit. No shortage of length, complexity or beauty
- 15 **Yering Station Yarra Valley VIC** 90  
Loads of lovely Pinot character on the nose with ripe cherry gamey notes and hints of "forest floor". Silky in texture the lingering flavour is enhanced by a touch of oak.
- 16 **Yabby Lake Mornington Peninsula VIC** 95  
Attractive rose petals, dark cherries and spice aromas. The palate is fine, tight and dry with a cherry and plum centre, balanced, savoury tannins.
- 12 **Seresin Leah Marlborough NZ** 96  
Savoury, spicy and earthy aromas with plum, berry and herbal notes. The palate is focused and plush with feminine red fruits, namely strawberry and ripe cherry.
- 14 **Michael Hall Adelaide Hills SA** 98  
This wine shows a beguiling interplay of glace cherry and wild strawberry, cinnamon, pomegranate, mossy bark, a hint of celery and soft talcum tannin.
- 14 **Craggy Range Te Muna Road Martinborough NZ** 110  
Medium-full bodied and elegantly proportioned, a concentrated core of savoury dark red berry and earthy fruit flavours is complexed by nuances of game and dried herb detail. This is an elegantly rich, complex and savoury flavoured Pinot Noir with freshness and fine structure.
- 15 **Ten Minutes by Tractor Estate Mornington Peninsula VIC** 112  
There's some beef here. It's a spicy, stewy, brooding pinot noir with a wealth of earth-like notes rising up from beneath. Fine, strict tannin completes a pretty impressive picture.
- 14 **Cloudy Bay Marlborough NZ** 115  
The palate is juicy but balanced by rich forest floor, clove and savoury flavours. Good tension between acid and fine tannins offers a well-rounded palate with appealing length.
- 15 **Two Paddocks Estate Central Otago NZ** 117  
Intense bright purple cherry fruits, plums, lots and lots of strawberries and raspberries and some maraschino; there is such depth on the nose. The palate has beautifully soft and supple tannins that sit smooth and even.

# PINOT NOIR

- 15 **William Downie Gippsland VIC** 140  
The Gippsland Pinot Noir is wonderfully balanced with blackcurrant, blackberry and hints of clove and nutmeg. Beautifully dense and concentrated on the palate, lifted violets and florals shine through along with the inextricably long finish.
- 14 **The Escarpment Kiwa Martinborough NZ** 146  
Complex, concentrated and intriguing, with fleshy blackberry and plum flavours at the core, showing highlights of black walnut, sandalwood, dried pine needle, black pepper and musky Darjeeling tea. The tannins are refined and plush, and the finish is epic.
- 14 **Kooyong Ferrous Mornington Peninsula VIC** 149  
Sweet, fresh, black-cherry and liqueur-cherry aromas that turn gloriously rich and almost opulent in the mouth. A complex pinot, with a glossy texture and wonderful balance.
- 12 **Savaterre Beechworth VIC** 150  
The extremely densely planted Savaterre vineyard sees low input biodynamic viticulture. This is a terroir driven pinot of great power, structure and intensity, seasoned in new, tight grained French oak.
- 15 **Mt Difficulty Packspur Vineyard Central Otago NZ** 152  
Leading with soft, velvety brambly wild raspberry, violet and wildflower florals. Rich red fruit gives the palate breadth, and is cleansed and lengthened by herbaceous savoury notes and elegant tannin and acid structure.
- 15 **Two Paddocks The Last Chance Central Otago NZ** 162  
One of the most unlikely places to grow grapes on earth is Two Paddock's Earnsclough vineyard. Concentrated, with firm and juicy black cherry and blackberry flavours that are generous and velvety, showing a range of star anise and black tea details. A fresh loamy earth note lingers on the long, powerful finish.
- 16 **Felton Road Cornish Point Central Otago NZ** 165  
The wine leads with attractive florals that are exotically perfumed with distinct old-fashioned rose and violets. An uncrowded palate showing opulent, rich deep fruits. Mocha, velvety and seductive tannins that lusciously coat the palate.
- 15 **Ata Rangi Martinborough NZ** 168  
Rosy, dark cherry, ripe and fleshy, a slip of vanilla oak. Medium bodied, smattering of orange peel and blood orange juice, silky tannin, gentle warmth, and a bold and sappy finish. Truly Grand Cru New Zealand Pinot Noir.
- 12 **Dry River Marlborough NZ** 190  
30% whole bunch. Very fine, expressive, pure red cherry fruit nose showing lovely finesse and fine spiciness. Very fine palate with fresh, taut red cherries. So linear and bright with real purity and firm but fine tannins and keen acidity.
- 13 **Bass Phillip Premium Gippsland VIC** 230  
So sure-footed and confident, it almost has a swagger. Cherry, sweet cinnamon and cedar oak, dried flowers, a little earthy bass. Medium bodied, silky and precise, with delectable savoury and fruit sweet switching, layered and complex already, laced up tight with ultra-fine pixel tannin, and long smashed strawberry and spice finish.

## RED VARIETALS

- 16 Chalmers Nero d'Avola Heathcote VIC 56**  
Vivid crimson colour; a frisky and very fragrant bouquet with raspberries leading the way; as they continue to do so on the light-bodied, fresh palate, tannins and oak are on a leave of absence.
- 16 Unico Zelo Truffle Hound Nebbiolo Clare Valley SA 59**  
This is the anti-Nebbiolo-Nebbiolo. An early released, jovial style for zippy, fun, delicious refreshment. Fine acidity and amaro-like savouriness make this a terrific food wine, while vibrant fruit and freshness make this wine simply gulpable on its own.
- 16 Save Our Souls Sangiovese Yarra Valley VIC 60**  
From cult winemaking legend, William Downie, this fresh and vibrant wine is abundant in soft black fruit and elegant florals. A long, fine tannin structure lends itself to a wide variety of food from our menu.
- 15 Shobbrook Novello Nebbiolo blend Adelaide Hills|Barossa SA 60**  
Tom Shobbrook is regarded as one of the leaders of the natural wine movement in Australia. This amazingly slurpable red is made from Nebbiolo from the Hills, blended with 90 year old Grenache and splashes of early picked Shiraz and Muscat de la Petit Grains. It's great chilled, so ask for an ice bucket!
- 13 Zema Cluny Cabernet|Merlot Coonawarra SA 68**  
This Cabernet blend is from the Zema family's non-irrigated hand-pruned vineyard the fruit lovingly crafted into an affordable premium wine.
- 14 Cape Mentelle Trinders Cabernet|Merlot Margaret River WA 69**  
Rich textured wine with blackcurrant, liqueur cherry and hints of sweet vanilla. Savoury, dusty oak provides depth and structure, finishing with chalky, dry tannins.
- 16 Cullen Mangan Merlot|Malbec|Petit Verdot Margaret River WA 72**  
Very attractive blend of raspberry, cherry and plum flavours. Already balanced wine that is backed by fine grained tannins. A juicy and pure fruit – driven wine
- 12 Pizzini Nebbiolo King Valley VIC 117**  
Red cherries, plummy depths and raspberry highlights provide balance to the strict, assertive tannin which marks Nebbiolo, making for a medium-bodied wine that can be enjoyed now.
- 15 Luke Lambert Nebbiolo Yarra Valley VIC 128**  
Luke says 2015 was just about perfect for him, with regards to Nebbiolo, and he picked riper and later, as the acids were holding on well. This is the first release to be raised in one of Luke's impressively big foudres. This is, in my mind, the most exciting release of Australian Nebbiolo to date.
- 10 Castagna Un Segreto Sangiovese|Shiraz Beechworth VIC 160**  
Julian Castagna is arguably Australia's most important and influential biodynamic producer, and this is one of his flagship wines. It opens with notes of fresh rich humus, turmeric, graphite, old polished leather with beautiful red fruit that creates a vibrant aromatic lift.

# SHIRAZ

- 14 Wirra Wirra Chook Block McLaren Vale SA 215**  
Only produced in exceptional vintages in tiny quantities from the biodynamically farmed Chook Block vineyard, planted in 1960. A layered and voluptuous wine with a core of opulent black fruit and McLaren Vale dark chocolate character, supported by fine, grainy tannins.
- 14 Henschke Mount Edelstone Eden Valley SA 300**  
Deep crimson with deep purple hues. Pure and complex, with lifted aromatics of violets, dark plums, fresh blackberries and blueberries, and aromas of crushed sage and cracked black pepper. The palate shows incredible purity and balance, with rich plum and blackberry fruit flavours, rosehip florals and savoury spice notes, finishing long with lingering plum skin and sage, and layers of fine, silky tannins.
- 09 Torbreck RunRig Barossa Valley SA 380**  
Ideal flowering and fruit set, along with slow ripening heralded one of the greatest RunRigs to date. This is a rarity in that it did not require the usual addition of Viognier. Aromas of raspberries, apricots and cassis, with a rich palate of blackberry, anise and dark chocolate.
- 06 Torbreck RunRig Barossa Valley SA 400**  
A powerful vintage possessing a dense, almost ink like hue. Aromas of red and black fruit meld with smoke, graphite and melted tar. The concentrated, multi layered palate exhibits marmalade, scorched earth and slow roasted meats.
- 05 Torbreck RunRig Barossa Valley SA 420**  
The freshness of a slightly cooler and longer ripening vineyard is still apparent after ample bottle aging. Bright red fruits and graphite combine seamlessly with game meats and wet earth. Still vibrant in acidity and deep rich fruit, with leather and spice slowly working towards the foreground.
- 12 Henschke Hill of Grace Eden Valley SA 1250**  
This flawless Hill of Grace is the ultimate iron fist in a velvet glove. While the fruit remains supreme, there are long savoury. Fragrant dark cherry and berry aromas and flavours are supported by French oak.
- 10 Henschke Hill of Grace Eden Valley SA 1100**  
The 2010 is a beautifully balanced wine; from a season that was perfect in many ways. I could sit and savour the nose on this wine for hours; exotic spices, sage, pepper and rich layers of blackberry, plum and cedar. These amazing old vines delivered a complex palate of dark brooding flavours, texture and refined silky tannins with incredible length.
- 09 Henschke Hill of Grace Eden Valley SA 1190**  
Deep red with crimson hues. Complex aromas of red currants, blackberry and marzipan with hints of five spice, dried herbs, black pepper, smoked charcuterie and layers of fine French oak. The palate is deep, rich and textural with a beautiful expression of berry fruits and spice, finishing with long, fine velvety tannins.
- 08 Henschke Hill of Grace Eden Valley SA 1250**  
The nose is attractive and enticing with aromas of sweet blackberry, blueberry. The palate is rich and concentrated with spicy plum, crushed herbs and Dutch licorice flavours. An amazing balance of acid, fruit intensity, weight and length create a powerful palate that finishes with long, fine tannins.
- 07 Henschke Hill of Grace Eden Valley SA 1290**  
Fine grained oak aromas, freshly lathed wood, dried herbs peeking through anise, pepper, five spice and then a lift of iodine wet earth note and the wash of dark, wild, brambly berry fruit. Elegant and medium bodied to taste with long, ropes of supple tannins laid like broadloom. It's seamless, notably long in flavour and layered to pleasing extreme.

## MERLOT

- 13 **Dutschke Block 80 Coonawarra SA** 58  
Deep in colour, with distinctive perfumed dark berry fruit and mouth-filling flavours.
- 16 **Unico Zelo Taboo Merlot Adelaide Hills SA** 83  
Sourced from a specialist Merlot vineyard in Lobethal in the Adelaide Hills and harvested with precision timing, resulting in a style rarely found in Australia. Structured tannins and vibrant acidity give length to the rich and brooding black fruit, while finishing subtly and delicately.
- 14 **Tarrawarra Estate Yarra Valley VIC** 85  
The "K Block" shows a dense core of sweet plum and blackcurrant fruit framed by toasty oak and some beautifully subtle herbaceous notes in the background.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 14 **Bleasdale Mulberry Tree Langhorne Creek SA** 52  
Aromas of mixed berries, dark chocolate and violets. The palate is smooth with blackcurrant and spicy oak flavours and finishes with fine chalky tannins.
- 14 **Xanadu Margaret River WA** 52  
Generous and beautifully structured palate, layered with dense fruits of the forest, ripe tannins and a persistent fruit finish.
- 15 **Smallfry Eden Valley SA** 65  
Suzy Hilder and Wayne Ahrens are serious, hands on winemakers. They are custodians of two historical certified biodynamic vineyards. Red and black forest fruits nestled in a bed of slightly grippy tannin. Fruit, structure, depth and complexity. Remarkable value for money given all the hard work put into their carefully cultivated vines.
- 09 **Mitchell Sevenhill Clare Valley SA** 68  
Dark crimson colour. Medium weight with a soft elegant structure, displaying refined flavours of blackcurrant, cedar and spice.
- 12 **Zema Family Selection Coonawarra SA** 68  
Complex dark fruits highlighted by hints of black currant, mulberry and dark chocolate. This palate is dominated by a concentration of ripe black berry fruits and has great depth and persistence. These characters are underwritten by complex toasty oak. It will take time to develop and show its full potential.
- 13 **Medhurst Yarra Valley VIC** 72  
Ripe and rich fruit spectrum - red cherries, blackberries, loquats and mulberries, all supported by cinnamon and spice aromas.
- 14 **Vasse Felix Margaret River WA** 96  
This was the first red wine to be produced in Margaret River, and has been made every year since 1972. A bouquet of spice, floral and savoury earthy notes combine with chocolate, while the palate is silky, with gentle mouth-coating tannins.

# CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 10 **Bellweather Coonawarra SA** 110  
Milk chocolate and classic very fine grain tannins. Hand pruned and picked, natural yeast fermentation.
- 14 **Wirra Wirra The Angelus McLaren Vale SA** 138  
A reaffirmation of the ability of McLaren Vale to produce Cabernet Sauvignon of great authority and power; black fruits are the order of the day, the tannins skilfully moulded, the oak integrated.
- 11 **Langmeil Jackamans Barossa Valley SA** 149  
Langmeil Jackamans Cabernet Sauvignon has developed a deliciously intense perfume of blackcurrants and mulberry with rich dark chocolates after two years in new and seasoned French oak hogsheads. A powerful wine from mature vines.
- 12 **Leeuwin Estate Art Series Margaret River WA** 149  
A gentle entry leads to a generously textured mid palate, finishing fine, with long and silky tannins. Classical blackcurrant and cherry fruits meet with dusty well integrated oak.
- 13 **Howard Park Abercrombie Great Southern WA** 188  
The deep and dark ruby colour implies the intensity and richness that is abundantly delivered on bouquet and palate.
- 11 **Cherubino Frankland River WA** 188  
Inky black, the wine has strong classic bay leaf and earth cabernet tones. Very focussed, mouth-filling with super fine tannins. Oak is supporting the intense fruit. Medium bodied, destined for a long life.
- 14 **Cullen Diana Madeline Margaret River WA** 195  
A blend of 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot, 3% Merlot, 2% Malbec and 2% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Biodynamic Cullen Vineyard. Structured and fruit driven with blackberries and spice with fine grained tannins.
- 14 **Mount Mary Quintet Yarra Valley VIC** 295  
The 2014 Quintet shows all the attributes of a quintessential Mount Mary Quintet. This release seems slightly more dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon characters rather than Merlot. As Dr. John would say "Good Cabernet should smell like Cabernet, let's not over-complicate it".
- 12 **Yalumba The Caley Cabernet Sauvignon|Shiraz SA** 590  
A blend of 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot, 3% Merlot, 2% Malbec and 2% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Biodynamic Cullen Vineyard. Structured and fruit driven with blackberries and spice with fine grained tannins.

## OTHER EUROPEAN RED WINES

- 13 **Nittnaus Kalk and Schieser Blaufränkisch Burgenland Austria** 88  
Biodynamically farmed grapes with no additions or adjustments to the wine. There is a freshness and vibrancy along with depth of flavour which makes this wine quite smashable, but also keeps your interest.
- 10 **Roda 1 Reserva Rioja Spain** 210  
All blue-black and sooo beautiful to smell: black animale meat'n'blood, plus road metal minerals gain pretty violet florals. The palate features astonishing tannin maturity, great spiciness with fine oak tucked way in at the back, while the fruit runs in the plum and cola range. It's power with enormous finesse and unfolds like a perfectly told story.
- 14 **Geantet-Pansiot Pinot Fin Bourgogne France** 140  
Founded in 1954, this wine has powerful fruit, but enough restraint not to be a blockbuster. Intense aromas of small red and black berries, with good balance and no hard edges.
- 05 **Domaine de Trévallon Baux de Provence France** 250  
This is one of the greatest estates of Provence, even though it is classified as Vin de Pays des Bouches due to its frowned upon blending of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah, and despite the blend's historical significance. Fermented in open foudres with minimal sulphur since the 1970's, this wine was natural before its time.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Veneto

Located in the North-East of Italy, Veneto is home to the famous Valpolicella and Amarone. The grapes for Amarone are dried to intensify the sugars of the fruit, which make these wines wonderfully intense.

- 14 Cantine Pra Morandina Valpolicella DOC 61  
Vibrant ruby red in colour with fresh cherry and plum aromas.
- 16 Michele Allegrini Valpolicella DOC 63  
Vibrant ruby red in colour with fresh cherry and plum aromas.
- 16 Monte Dall'Ora Saseti Valpolicella Classico DOC 63  
Biodynamically farmed grapes with no additions or adjustments to the wine. There is a freshness and vibrancy along with depth of flavour which makes this wine quite quaffable, but also keeps your interest.
- 16 Le Salette Valpolicella Classico DOC 68  
Alluring aromas of exotic spice, purple flower, dark-skinned berry and a balsamic note lead the nose. The concentrated palate delivers dried cherry, ripe plum, mint, licorice and a hint of game alongside velvety tannins that wrap around the finish. It nicely balances weight and finesse.
- 13 Bertani Secco Bertani IGT 125  
An intense red colour with ruby highlights. Hints of redcurrants, blackberries and cocoa powder on the nose, together with spicy notes of black pepper, cloves and nutmeg. On the palate a pleasant flavour of red fruit, sour cherries, concentrated cherry and black tea, followed by fine, powdery tannins with a coffee bean finish.
- 13 Giuseppe Campagnola Amarone Classico D.O.C.G. 140  
On the palate it's ample and sweet, with moderate berry fruit that has some prune accents supported by peppery spice and tannins that have a peppery balsamic burr, and flow into a fairly long bitter finish with a cocoa underpinning.
- 13 Le Salette La Meregga de Valpolicella Amarone Classico D.O.C.G. 175  
There is a great persistence, purity and focus to this wine. Blackcurrant and cranberries are interwoven with cream and gentle oak spice. An edgy sweet and sour fruit character creeps through. This is fresh and very drinkable.
- 11 Tenuta Sant'Antonio Amarone della Valpolicella Classico D.O.C.G. 180  
Campo Dei Gigli is the oldest Sant'Antonio vineyard and is dedicated to the lily, the flower that symbolises Tenuta Sant'Antonio. Wild fruits, woody hints and mineral tones with aromas of liquorice, black pepper, tobacco, spices and chocolate.
- 11 L'Arco Amarone della Valpolicella Classico D.O.C.G. 195  
Made only from autochthonous grapes (corvina, rondinella, molinara). The best clusters are selected to dry in the cellar for 100 days. Red garnet coloured, with rich ripe cherry and dark berry flavours.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Trentino – Alto Adige

Trentino is an autonomous wine-producing province in the far north of Italy, bordering Lombardy to the west and Veneto to the south and east. The province forms the southern half of the Trentino-Alto Adige region, the other half being Alto Adige (Sudtirol to its largely German-speaking population).

From the Trentino region, we are highlighting one of the truly exciting producers of Italian wine. Elizabetta Foradori is largely responsible for resurrecting Trentino's much forgotten Teroldego grape from the brink of extinction and producing some of Italy's finest, most age worthy wines. All wines are wild fermented with indigenous yeast and Demeter certified biodynamic.

From Alto Adige, the sustainable, holistic working methods of Alois Lagedar yield a wonderful balance of natural acid and tannin. These are some of the finest Pinot Noir wines in Italy.

- 14 Foradori Teroldego Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT 95**  
The Campo Rotaliano is a well-demarcated geographical area, a sort of recess of the Adige Valley tucked between the mountains. Its history and origin are closely tied to the Noce River, which, over the centuries, has deposited huge quantities of limestone, granite and porphyry debris. Within this small plain, depending on the soil composition, various micro zones can be distinguished, bearing various names given by the local vintners. The wines from the vineyards with a predominantly sandy soil are blended to produce "Foradori" wine.
- 14 Foradori Teroldego Sgarzon Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT 134**  
"Sgarzo" means vine shoot in the Campo Rotaliano. The vines that grow in the Sgarzon vineyard are particularly vital and benefit from the cooler climate that distinguishes this site. Teroldego's character changes, it is enriched with an unusual freshness. The eight months spent on the skins in amphorae (tinajas from Villarobledo, Spain), retain and amplify its distinctiveness. Along with the Morei vineyard, the Sgarzon strongly expresses the great variability that this variety.
- 13 Foradori Teroldego Granato Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT 179**  
Grapevines and pomegranates have the same geographical origins and are typical of the Mediterranean region. The pomegranate also has the same charm, beauty and intensity of the grape. The "Granato" is inspired by this ideal blend, an especially concentrated and dense Teroldego whose roots plunge into the stones of three different vineyards of the Campo Rotaliano.
- 15 Alois Lageder Pinot Noir Alto Adige DOC 93**  
Fruit comes from selected vineyards in Pochi and Appiano at an altitude of 300m to 450m. Elegant and pretty, but with great length and development. Fresh, bright red fruit is balanced by spice and soft, silky tannins.
- 13 Alois Lageder Krafuss Pinot Noir Alto Adige DOC 160**  
In comparison with the 2015 vineyard blend, this wine, in Burgundian terms, is the "La Tâche" of Italy. Elegant up front, but complete in its luscious intensity.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Piemonte

Nebbiolo, the greatest Italian red varietal is grown and made here, with Barolo the epicentre for the finest Nebbiolo wines. Lighter, fresher Dolcetto and Barbera wines are great value, easy drinking styles, perfect for kicking back in the Locale Bar, and work well straight from the ice bucket.

- 15 **Oltretorrente Barbera|Dolcetto Colli Tortonesi DOC** 58  
Oltretorrente vineyards are located in Paderna in the evocative hilly area of Tortona. Their organic methods significantly reduce the yields, but this is of benefit to the complexity and structure of wines: in fact the old vines produce less but the plants are more balanced and grapes are richer and deeper in their characteristics.
- 13 **Amalia Dolcetto d'Alba DOC** 59  
Pleasing aroma, with red fruity and almonds. The sensations are exalted by a great breadth and persistence.
- 15 **Prunotto Dolcetto d'Alba DOC** 65  
This is full-bodied, grippy, plum-fruited, spicy with great length.
- 14 **Elvio Cogno Mandorlo Dolcetto d'Alba DOC** 70  
The nose is intense and persistent, with scents of red berries. It is a full-bodied, elegant and round wine, with notes of red and black fruit and almond.
- 14 **Renato Corino Barbera d'Alba DOC** 75  
Simply stunning, elegant, clean, full fruit and velvety texture with notes of brown spice, deep red fruit and cassis. Good acidity and balancing tannins. Medium length finish.
- 15 **Burlotto Barbera d'Alba DOC** 78  
Rich, vibrant and lively taste different wines rich fruity flavour, pleasant acidity, soft tannins and a long berry-fruity aftertaste.
- 12 **Aldo Conterno Conca tre Pile Barbera d'Alba DOC** 126  
Deep ruby red, with dark berry perfumes overlaid with spiced, dark plum and cherries. On the palate, it is concentrated and full-bodied, with the classic Barbara acidity lifting and accentuating the red fruit characters. Blackberries, savoury spice and nutmeg blend with ripe plums and supple tannins. Long, elegant finish.
- 14 **Vietti Langhe Nebbiolo DOC** 115  
As one would expect from Nebbiolo the nose of this wine has a somewhat split personality; savoury aromas of earth, tar, tobacco and leather contrasted with lifted floral overtones, violets, cherries, the works.
- 13 **Albino Rocca Barbaresco DOCG** 150  
Sweet tobacco, mint, licorice and dark cherry all lift from the glass. Aromatic and lifted in style, there is also plenty of tannic grip and enough structure for interest, although this is an early drinking style.
- 10 **Elio Sandri Perno Barolo DOCG** 150  
From 3700 vines planted in 1937, this is the source of greatness. These old vines are in tune with their wonderful mostly south facing position and yield fruit that is balanced, rich and deep with flavour and harmony.
- 12 **Aldo Conterno Il Favot Langhe Nebbiolo DOC** 176  
Rose petals, scorched earth, baking spices and tar hold the juicy succulent red fruits.
- 11 **Aldo Conterno Il Favot Langhe Nebbiolo DOC** 195  
The medium weight palate shows soft accessible fruit with light to medium tannins on a medium length finish.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Piemonte

- 08 **Cascina Cucco Vigna Cucco Barolo DOCG** 175  
A complex and enveloping bouquet where the varietal hints of wild rose blend with the aroma of sage. On the palate, blackberries and sour black cherries are complemented by spices and wild overtones.
- 11 **Sottimano Cottá Barbaresco DOCG** 180  
Sweet floral and spice notes meld into a core of dark red and black hued stone fruits, tobacco, smoke and new leather. The characteristic pliant, juicy Cottá fruit is there, but it is complemented by expressive floral overtones.
- 12 **Fratelli Alessandria Monvigliero Barolo DOCG** 185  
Monvigliero sings of the vineyard's steep, white-talc slopes, with its pale, red-rose colour, and rose-petal scent, along with vintage-specific notes of violet creams. This is a haunting, ethereal, fresh, mandarin-skin and rose-petal beauty, wrapped up by the finest of tannins and a salty lick.
- 12 **Vietti Castiglione Barolo DOCG** 195  
Sweet red cherry, pomegranate, wild flowers and spices all meld together in a sensual, radiant wine endowed with striking presence and intensity. In 2012, the Castiglione is especially lifted, radiant and expressive, with striking purity and nuance.
- 12 **Capellano Piè Rupestris Otin Fiorin Barolo DOCG** 199  
Cappellano has been quietly producing some of the greatest Barolo, flying under the radar and shunning the scoring system due to a firm belief that winemaking is an art-form that cannot be encapsulated by numbers. Grown on original rootstock and made naturally with long maceration.
- 01 **Aldo Conterno Quartetto IGT** 195  
This wine leans toward Nebbiolo, appropriately, but in a diluted form from Cabernet, Barbera and Dolcetto component additions. In the mouth it's medium but rich, ripe, ready, completely void of any tannins and shows good balancing acidity. It's very classy and together, and for me almost a bit distracting during dinner because of its perfection.
- 11 **Luciano Sandrone Le Vigne Barolo DOCG** 275  
Rose petal, mint, crushed flowers, sweet red berries and cinnamon are some of the many notes that take shape in the glass. A wine of exquisite perfume and aromatic lift, the 2011 Le Vigne is all about finesse and pure texture. With time in the glass, the 2011 blossoms into a layered, head-turning wine. This is a great effort from Sandrone.
- 06 **Aldo Conterno Cicala Barolo DOCG** 315  
Cicala is the most fruit-driven, but also the most tannic and most age-worthy of the estate's trio of single-vineyard Barolos. Thickly textured with concentrated forest fruit, its layers of mineral, liquorice, and smoke add complexity that mellows into a fine, lingering finish.
- 13 **Gaja Barbaresco DOCG** 575  
In the mouth there are flavours of cherry, plum, spice, leather. Quite juicy with savoury ripe chalky tannin that is more on the mid palate than the front of mouth but present throughout and introducing a liquorice element. Carries long on the palate with touches of rose.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Toscana

For its strength of image this province is easily the best known and most evocative. The principle grape is Sangiovese. Often blended with other varieties, it has become one of the highest selling wines in the modern world.

- 14 **Antinori Santa Cristina Toscana IGT** 43  
On the palate the wine is smooth and well-balanced. The finish is characterized by gentle tannins and the persistent flavour of the grapes which make it so delicious and easy to drink.
- 15 **Bonacchi Chianti Riserva DOCG** 50  
The aging in oak barrels gives this wine ruby red colour with garnet hues. It has an intense aroma and a dry velvety flavour. Lots of acidity and tart cherry notes. Medium-bodied and smooth. Cries out for food.
- 16 **Fiore Nero Chianti DOC** 53  
Intense and lively ruby-red colour. Rich aroma of wild berries, violet notes, and hints of spice. On the palate it is full bodied and well balanced, with soft, elegant tannins.
- 14 **Le Ragnaie Poggio Anima Toscana IGT** 57  
Poggio Anima Sangiovese is a well-priced Sangiovese is organically farmed from 15 year old vines. Full-bodied with a mixed palate of red fruit, wild herbs (sage and rosemary), and exotic spices.
- 14 **Rocca di Castagnoli Fattoria di Scannano Chianti DOCG** 60  
Semi translucent dark crimson red colour with a tinge of black around the edges and a dark red hue. The nose exhibits spicy dark cherry aromas followed by some cedar and light dried meat notes. Light and savoury with good fruit the palate has flavours of dark cherries, dried meats and spicy cedar. Soft fine grained tannins.
- 15 **Antinori Pèppoli Chianti Classico DOCG** 69  
Lively and elegant, showing herb, black cherry and spice flavours backed by dusty tannins. There's moderate length on the finish.
- 14 **Casale Colli Senesi Chianti DOC** 75  
Bright, vibrant, fresh and energetic. Delicate fragrance of violet and iris, lingers on the palate. Crisp, crunchy and fun.
- 15 **Talenti Rosso di Montalcino DOC** 85  
Intense, fresh and fruity scent with the varietals notes of cherry, plums and black cherry. Soft and mineral taste with a good structure and well-balanced tannins.
- 14 **Tenute dell'Ornellaia Le Volte DOC** 89  
Le Volte demonstrates a good depth of dark fruit with accompanying dried herbs and spice. The mouthfeel is dense and quite smooth despite the tannins, with a delightful minty finish. Fine acidity ties everything together

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Toscana

- 14 Isole e Olena Chianti Classico DOCG 92**  
Dark fruit and pressed flowers on the nose. Tight, young and grippy palate with racy plum and cherry fruit, touches of pepper and an aromatic, herby finish. A wine of depth and fascinating complexity.
- 13 Poggio Scalette Chianti Classico DOCG 96**  
The notes of Chianti Classico-style Sangiovese dominate the nose and fuse perfectly with a Cabernet which is equally important in characterizing this wine. On the palate the wine is highly pleasurable, supple, round, and soft in texture and savoury as well. Tonic and vibrant sensations characterize a notably elegant finish and aftertaste.
- 14 Le Macchiule Bolgheri Rosso DOC 104**  
A rich and layered red with plum and currants. Full bodied, with plenty of juicy ripe fruit with fine tannins to give the wine drive. Made from predominantly Merlot, with Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah.
- 13 Casanova di Neri Rosso di Montalcino DOC 108**  
Hints of maraschino cherry, violets and red fruits. Great fineness in the mouth with tannin that is still young but of excellent quality. Long lasting, elegant and persistent. This really is baby Brunello. While totally smashable right now, it also has serious power and structure.
- 14 Marchese Antinori Chianti Classico DOCG 110**  
The notes of Chianti Classico-style Sangiovese dominate the nose and fuse perfectly with a Cabernet which is equally important in characterizing this wine. On the palate the wine is highly pleasurable, supple, round, and soft in texture and savoury as well. Tonic and vibrant sensations characterize a notably elegant finish and aftertaste.
- 12 Pian delle Vigne Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 163**  
Velvety and rich, this wine whooshes across the palate with considerable softness and roundness, yet it's also remarkably structured; this Brunello mixes accessibility with longevity in a wine that's replete with chewy tannins and vibrant acidity.
- 11 Isole e Olena Cepparello Toscana IGT 180**  
Lovely seductive bouquet of cherries, dark berries, coffee, spices and some liquorice. Some oak and vanilla in the back. With time in decanter a nice meaty note appears. Good acidity, nice grip, medium plus in the body, firm but still quite soft tannins.
- 11 Gaja Pieve di Santa Restituta Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 185**  
In the palate, this Brunello di Montalcino expresses ripe tannins, integrated acidity, rich structure and a lingering finish. Succulent, pure red fruit bursts from the glass, accompanied by crushed wildflowers, wet river rocks, cypress, exotic spices and warm cigar wrapper.
- 08 Casanova di Neri Tenuta Nuova Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 220**  
Tenuta Nuova is a pioneering and visionary vineyard project embodying the belief and passion of Casanova di Neri. Tenuta Nuova means new property; Tenuta Nuova is a place where nobody planted Sangiovese before balsamic and red fruit notes, while in the mouth shows itself with ripen and silky tannins which are supported by a vibrant finish.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Toscana

- 12 **Baricci Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** 185  
Enticing perfumed berry, violet, new leather and truffle scents emerge in this textbook Brunello. On the savoury, full-bodied palate, licorice, clove and chopped herb flavours accent a juicy core of ripe black cherry fruit.
- 09 **Le Ragnaie Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** 185  
This is very pretty and supple on the palate, yet with flavours that are also quite forward. Dried cherries, sweet tobacco, wild flowers, mint and anise meld together in a delicate.
- 09 **Tenute Silvio Nardi Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** 190  
Silvio's daughter, Emilia Nardi, took over her father's company in 1962, and has since been producing fine and structured Brunella. Hints of anise, ripe wild berries and a touch of vanilla. Supple tannins, great structure and good length.
- 12 **Frescobaldi Castel Giocondo Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** 205  
Castelgiocondo Brunello di Montalcino is a clear ruby red with garnet highlights. Pronounced notes of blackberry are elegantly accompanied by floral notes such as violet. The nose is complex and well-blended: spicy notes of black pepper and clove, tobacco and leather, and "jus de viande" reflect well the evolution of the wine. Resonating tannin textures, mellow structure with a long and elegant finish.
- 09 **Canalicchio di Sopra Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** 230  
Canalicchio di Sopra has been family owned since it was founded in 1962. Intense fruit flavours with a harmonious hint of forest floor.
- 13 **Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia Bolgheri Sassicaia DOC** 350  
Intense, concentrated and deep ruby-colored, this wine offers elegant, complex aromas of red fruit. In the mouth it is rich and dense, yet harmonious, with sweet, balanced tannins. The wine has a long finish with a depth and structure that ensure its extraordinary longevity.
- 14 **Gaja Magari Ca'Marcanda Magari Bolgheri DOC** 350  
Inky dark, exploding with aromas of juicy berries, exotic spices, cigar wrapper and fresh-cut herbs. This was a warm, ripe vintage, so the wine holds immediate appeal.
- 11 **Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia Bolgheri Sassicaia DOC** 395  
Tenuta San Guido called the 2011 growing season "truly exceptional," and this silky, enveloping bottling testifies to the truth of that description. Juicy red and brambly blue fruits all but reach from the glass, all framed by cedar, fresh-cut herbs, minerals, baking spices and sun-warmed earth. Balanced, concentrated, and harmonious, the '11 Sassicaia glides across the palate with a silky feel, and its mineral core propels it to a vibrant, lingering finish.
- 07 **Gaja Rennina Brunello di Montalcino** 650  
The designation Rennina first appears in the High Middle Ages and is derived from the late-Roman name of the estate, Fundus Rescianum, denoting a state-owned farm. Since the Gaja family's acquisition of the historic estate in 1994, three growing sites have been devoted to the cultivation of Sangiovese grapes for the production of Brunello di Montalcino: Santo Pietro (St. Peter), Castagno (Chestnut Tree), and Pian dei Cerri (Turkish Oak Flats). Here, lime-rich subsoils, southwest exposure, and ventilation arriving from the Tyrrhenian sea to the west deliver well-balanced Brunello di Montalcino, defined by its characteristic red fruit notes, minerality, and polished tannins.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Abruzzo

Italy is seldom known for the simplicity of its wines, yet the ruggedly mountainous region of Abruzzo offers an abundance of delightful, uncomplicated wines that tend to represent good value.

- 14 **Contesa Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC** 53  
Medium-bodied, with fresh plum, mocha and olive notes that push through the finish.

## Puglia

The southern portion of the region is a flat and fertile peninsula that forms the characteristic heel of the Italian "boot". Puglia has always been the engine-room of Italian wine production. This region is mitigated by constant sea breezes - especially from both sides of the southerly Salento peninsula - and long-established bush vines offer some resistance to drought. On these lands, they grow indigenous grapes such as Nero di Troia, Aglianico, Falanghina, Primitivo, Salice Salentino. Rio, our restaurant owner, has a particular affinity with this region as he was born and raised there.

- 14 **I Monili Primitivo Tarantino IGP** 42  
Soft, smooth Italian red from the deep south. From the same stable as our much-loved Negro Amaro, this Primitivo varietal is a lovely comforting wine. Smooth enough to drink on its own, but robust enough to go well with your favourite Italian dishes.
- 13 **Conte Onofrio Spagnoletti Castel del Monte DOC** 49  
Uva di Troia – the dark-skinned grape on which most Castel del Monte red wines are based – is a local grape variety capable of creating high-quality wines with some of southern Italy's most characterful wines.
- 15 **12 e Mezzo Negromaro del Salento IGP** 55  
Ruby red wine with shades of purple, the nose presents fascinating scents of wild berries. The palate is marked by notes of vanilla with long persistence.
- 12 **A Mano Primitivo Puglia IGT** 56  
Deeply coloured and exuberant on the nose, with perfumes of ripe, red fruit, especially raspberries and a spicy, smoky edge from the oak ageing. On the palate it is youthful and full-bodied, with great balance between ripe, rounded fruit characters including blackberry and blueberry, sweet, toasty oak and ripe, full tannins.
- 09 **Agricola Vallone Vereto Salice Salentino Riserva DOP** 70  
Bright colour, with lively sour cherry fruit supported by dusky brambly bitterness and smoky acidity while the tannins are bright and smooth, flowing into a clean bitter finish that continues at length.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Puglia

- 13 Leone De Castris Salice Salentino Riserva DOC 70**  
Wine of an intense red colour with garnet coloured hints, made of Negroamaro and Malvasia Nera. On the nose, fruity sensations of blackberry and black cherry, notes of basil and sweet spices due to the refinement in oak barrels. On the palate, smooth and balanced with a strong but never intrusive tannin. Long lasting finish.
- 13 Pietraventosa Ossimoro Murgia IGT 63**  
Grown on gravely Limestone , the wine shows explosive aromas of ripe plum and ripe pickled cherries. Rich and powerful on the palate with spice and ripe fruit flavours. Finishes fresh with a slight noble bitter chocolate note. 75% Primitivo , 25% Aglianico
- 08 Masseria Maime Negromaro Salento IGT 96**  
Deep ruby red colours with aromas of plums and sour cherries, with muscular flavours of summer fruits and oak. Chewy mouth feel with full body and a long finish.
- 13 Papale Primitivo di Manduria DOP 105**  
The Primitivo selection comes from grapes carefully selected in the heart of DOP and harvested by hand in small boxes, Papale was born from this gold line. Ruby red, with a round and soft taste that invokes aromas of jam and berries. A wine that admirably identifies its territory with its important structure, while respecting the elegance that sets it apart.
- 15 Guttarolo Negromaro Puglia IGT 115**  
Vineyard work is excellent, organic and done entirely by hand, while Cristiano eschews the use of additives entirely in hope of making the sort of wines he likes to drink. While the wines are unmistakably Pugliese, full of wild, sun-drenched fruit, they have a balance often missing in the region, one that allows the grape and place to sing and the drinker to enjoy that hazy minerality that karst soils bring.
- 08 Rivera Il Falcone Castel del Monte Riserva DOC 125**  
This blend opens up with aromas of cherry, blueberry, sweet balsamic, leather, earthy and spicy. The palate has great structure with firm and gritty tannins, lively acidity and good fruit concentration. An explosion of flavours on the finish with a trace of minerality and silky tannins. A full bodied red with a lot of personality, strongly recommended.
- 08 Bocca di Lupo Castel del Monte DOP 126**  
Lots of juicy berry and plum, with hints of spice and mineral.  
Full-bodied with spicy fresh fruit on the palate, firm tannins and a clean, mineral finish.
- 08 Rivera Puer Apuliae Nero di Troia Castel del Monte DOC 165**  
Named after King Federico II who left an important cultural mark on southern Italy, Puer Apuliae ("the son of Puglia") is an iconic wine made using indigenous Nero di Troia grapes. The wine opens with soft chocolate, ripe cherry, espresso, spice and blackberry aromas. The mouth feel is soft, plush and firm.
- 12 Gianfranco Fino Es Primitivo di Manduria DOC 195**  
Intense, opaque ruby red. Purple rim. Consistent. Nice, complex rich nose. Very fine, with red fruits and sweet spices. Wonderful at taste: velvety, wrapping my mouth with integrated tannins and fruit.

# ITALIAN RED WINES

## Sicilia

One of Europe's oldest wine growing regions, the island is home to some unique varietals not found anywhere else. Many modern Sicilian producers have embraced ancient farming and winemaking techniques, resulting in expressive wines that are equal to the best of any of the great regions of Italy.

- 15 **Cottanera Barbazzale Etna DOC** 55  
Barbazzale Rosso, Nerello Mascalese with a low percentage of Nerello Cappuccio, is vibrant ruby red, perfect for first-time wine drinkers. Delightful scents of raspberry and blackberry, wild flowers interwoven with light mineral scents. Very pleasant freshness on the palate, with a fresh tasting hint of acid.
- 15 **Ciello Rosso Nero d'Avola Terre Siciliane IGP** 56  
Medium bodied and juicy with crunchy plummy fruit, dark spice, coffee and tobacco. Organic farming, wild yeast ferment and 60% whole bunch, resulting in wonderful, long, fine tannins.
- 13 **Feudo Arancio Riserva Sicilia DOC** 59  
Made entirely with Nero d'Avola, this round, chewy red offers ripe wild cherry, crushed raspberry, cinnamon and vanilla flavours. Smooth, velvety tannins support the juicy flavours and give it a polished texture. It's savory and accessible and will offer pure drinking enjoyment over the next few years.
- 13 **Mazzei Zisola Sicilia DOC** 85  
Deep, dark red colour with dark red hue. The nose displays very ripe notes of black cherry and stewed plum followed by some liquorice, spice, cedar and earth. Medium in weight, the palate delivers flavours of black plums and dark cherries followed by some earth and spice. A dry finish with velvet smooth tannins, this wine is elegant and concentrated with great depth.
- 16 **Occhipinti SP68 Rosso Vittoria Classico IGT** 90  
Arianna Occhipinti is one of the hottest names in Italian wines. Her natural wines are fresh and pure; delicate, yet full flavoured and glide across the palate.
- 14 **COS Cerasuolo di Vittoria Classico IGT** 105  
The Cerasuolo di Vittoria is a deep ruby red colour. It has aromas of dried cherry, chocolate, smoke, herb and spice. It gains some liquorice notes with time in the glass. Soft round fruity medium bodied palate with a good dose of acidity. The wines gives off dried cherry, truffle and smoky flavours in the mouth. Long finish.
- 12 **Masseria Setteporte Nerello Mascalese Etna DOC** 135  
Dark raspberry and coffee with seemingly endless depth. Fruit heft, elegant black pepper, dark flowers and dirt, come-hither tannins, spring leaves, chocolate and ink, and then an entire, complex derivative phase for a heart-tugging finish and bitter, ocean spray tannins, surprisingly parallel to the bouquet; every sip a relay.
- 14 **Girolamo Russo Fuedo di Mezzo Etna Rosso DOC** 149  
Nerello Mascalese with small percentages of Nerello Cappuccio. Sweet and soft crushed fruit nose, on the palate wonderful fragrant fruit, floral and smoky. Elegant but with textured body.
